Andrew Beacham International Sports Scholarships 2026

Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility Criteria

1. This scholarship applies to students commencing full-time undergraduate or postgraduate study at Hartpury University in September 2026 only and may be subject to change in future academic years.
2. To be eligible for consideration, you must:
 - Be classified as an international student for tuition fee purposes (as stated in your offer letter).
 - Have received an offer to study a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate degree at Hartpury University.
 - Be eligible to represent the relevant Hartpury Sports Academy in your chosen sport, where required.

Scholarships are available to students enrolling in one of Hartpury's recognised Sports Academies: Equine, Men's Rugby, Women's Rugby, Men's Football, Women's Football, Golf, Cricket, Netball, Rowing, or Athlete Performance. Exceptionally, postgraduate applicants in receipt of a Hartpury sport studentship may also be considered, including non-playing roles, where this scholarship represents the higher-value award.

2. Allocation Process

1. Scholarships are allocated using a phased rolling window model:
 - 3 awards released September–December
 - 4 awards released January–March
 - 3 awards released April–June
 - Any unallocated awards may roll forward to the next phase.
2. Applications are assessed using a formal scoring matrix which considers:
 - Playing standard
 - Impact on squad
 - Impact of scholarship

3. Decisions are made jointly by the Head of the relevant Sports Academy and the Director of Elite Sport. For Rugby scholarships, decisions will also involve the Head of Performance Rugby and the Head of Rugby Operations. All decisions are final and there is no right of appeal.

3. Scholarship Value and Payment

1. Scholarships are awarded as tuition fee discounts only. No cash alternative is available.
2. To secure the award, you must:
 - Accept your academic offer.
 - Pay a tuition fee deposit equivalent to 50% of your first-year tuition fee.
3. The scholarship will be deducted from the remaining balance of tuition fees due and applied to the second tuition fee instalment. A revised invoice will be issued following confirmation of award.
4. The tuition fee discount cannot be used in place of the required tuition fee deposit.

4. Duration and Continuation of Award

1. International Sports Scholarships are awarded for each year of study for the standard duration of the programme, subject to annual review.
2. Continuation of the scholarship beyond the first year is conditional upon:
 - Satisfactory academic progression (passing required modules)
 - Academy engagement
 - Discipline and Behaviour
3. The University reserves the right to review, suspend or withdraw a scholarship at any time where a student:
 - Fails to achieve the required academic progression.
 - Demonstrates poor academic engagement.
 - Fails to participate appropriately in academy training, competition or related commitments.
 - Is subject to disciplinary action.
4. Where a scholarship is withdrawn during a subsequent year of study, the student will be liable for the full international tuition fee applicable for that academic year.

6. Deferral and Withdrawal

1. If you defer your entry, the scholarship cannot be carried forward. The award will be withdrawn, and you may be eligible to reapply in the following academic year.
2. If you withdraw during your studies:
 - Your scholarship will be cancelled.
 - You will be required to pay the international tuition fee applicable for the period studied, in line with the University's Tuition Fee Policy.
3. The University reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship if tuition fee payments are not made in line with agreed deadlines.

7. Multiple Awards and Sponsorship

1. Students may receive only one Hartpury scholarship. If eligible for multiple awards, the highest value scholarship will be applied.
2. Applicants in receipt of any other Hartpury scholarship, bursary, funding or discount (excluding the early payment discount) are not eligible.
3. You are not eligible if you receive external sponsorship covering tuition fees, or tuition fees and living costs, where the University invoices a third party directly (e.g. government, charity or private organisation).

8. General

1. Scholarships are awarded at the University's discretion.
2. The University reserves the right to amend, suspend or withdraw this scholarship scheme at any time.
3. All decisions regarding scholarship awards are final.
